A BRIEF REPORT OF ACTIVITIES

Ramakrishna Mission, Narottam Nagar, a branch of the Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission, was started in 1971 to serve the tribal people of Arunachal Pradesh at the request of our Late Prime Minister Smt. Indira Gandhi. It has now completed 52 years of service in the field of Education, Medical and other Philanthropic services. Students of various tribes come here from different parts of Arunachal. It has now 515 students, out of which 425 are resident. Its services are open to all, irrespective of caste, creed, and religion. The reason why education has been chosen as the special field of service is that the right type of education is the best and most effective means of doing lasting good to the society. We, therefore, have been trying to impart academic education based on the educational principles of Swami Vivekananda, retaining the best traditions of our country while instructing them in modern arts, science, culture, crafts, and other vocational studies.

The academic session began this year on 30thApril 2023. Classes began after a special assembly on 2nd May 2023.

The results of the academic session 2022-23 were declared on 30th March 2023. The Aptitude test of class I and XI were held on 26th February 2023 and 19th May 2023 respectively.

Academic Achievements:

In class X (AISSE - 2023), 38 students appeared and 38 passed; 33 passed in 1st Division and 05 in 2nd Division. 04 students scored 90% and above, 15 scored 80% and above, 21 scored 75% and above.

Master Teaphang Khoisia was the highest scorer with 95.00%. In class XII (AISSCE - 2023), 32 students appeared and 32 passed; 31 passed in 1st Division and 01 in 2nd Division. 02 students scored 90% and above, 11 students scored 80% and above, 14 scored 75% and above. Master Larcheng Motu was the highest scorer with 92.80%.

Sports and Games Achievements:

There are six playgrounds and a stadium. Students enjoy playing games like Football, Volleyball, Basketball & Cricket etc.; Carom and Table Tennis are played as indoor games.

Inter block/house tournaments were held among the students in various games. In the Higher Secondary section, Acharya Ramanuja Block was the winner in football, volleyball, cricket, Acharya Vivekananda Block was the winner in basketball. In the Secondary section, Prithviraj Chauhan Housewas the winner in football, cricket, Rana Pratap House was the winner in Volleyball, and Samrat Ashoka House was the winner in Basketball.

48th Annual Athletic meet was held on 15th & 16th December 2023. Sri Biplab Kanti Sengupta, Professor, Department of Architecture and Regional Planning, Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur, West Bengal, the chief guest inaugurated the meet and addressed the students. Mst. Wangpho Wangsa of class VI, Mst. Samhen Jongsam of class IX, Mst. Sandong Bangyang of class IX, and Mst. Wangseng Lowang of class XI were judged champions in their respective groups. Sri Biplab Kanti Sengupta declared the meet closed in the evening.

Other Achievements:

To imbibe the spirit of competition our students are encouraged to participate in various contests.

Mst. Narang Doging, class XII (21-22 batch) secured ST-146th All India Rank in NEET 2023 and Mst. Dorjee Khandu Naksang, class XII (21-22batch) secured ST - 386th Rank in IIT-JEE 2023. He got admitted in IIT, Chennai. Mst. Gumli Romin, Mst. Tabom Pali and Mst. Zenith Singkhom, class XII (21-22 batch) got admitted in NIT, Rourkela, NIT Jaipur and IIIT, Bhopal respectively.

Mst. Nokgo Ngodam, Mst. Choakwang Wangsu, and Mst. Chonkai Wangpan of class 8 (2022-23) were selected for the National Means cum Merit Scholarship in 2023.

Mst. Gabreil Nalo of class X (22-23) secured second place in NEE-1 conducted by NERIST.

Mst. Teaphang Khoisia, Class X (22-23), got selected for the prestigious Dera Natung Award conferred by the Department of Secondary Education, Arunachal Pradesh, for securing the 5th position in the CBSE class X exam among boys in the state.

Bhutoria Memorial Trust, Kolkata awarded 6 students the Bhutoria Memorial Scholarship a sum of rupees 42,000/- has been distributed.

Special Facilities for ST students of Arunachal Pradesh:

In Ramakrishna Mission School, during the year 2022-23, 120 ST students from Arunachal Pradesh received FREE education. An approximate amount of rupees 33,72,799/- had been spent for the maintenance of these students.

In Ramakrishna Mission Sarada Vidyalaya during the year 2022-23, 125 ST students of Arunachal Pradesh received FREE education. An approximate amount of rupees. 21,61,004/had been spent for the maintenance of these students.

Students' visit to Kolkata

Class XII students went to Kolkata on December 22, 2023, and returned on December 29, 2023. They went to the renowned Dakshineswar Kali Temple on December 24 and participated in the All India Youth Convention at Belur Math on December 25 and 26. On December 26, during the conference, they presented a brief performance with a few tribal songs and dances centered around the topic of 'The Ramakrishna Mission in Arunachal Pradesh'. They went to Holy Mother's House, Swamiji's Ancestral House, and other destinations in Kolkata on December 27. They left for Kamarpurkur and Jayrambati on December 28, the birth places of Bhagavan Sri Ramakrishna and Holy Mother Sri Sarada Devi respectively. On December 29, they played a friendly football match with the students of Ramakrishna Mission Students Home at Belgharia. On December 31, 2023, students returned after their excursion.

Medical Aid

All the students and staff members are provided with FREEmedical aid under a qualified doctor assisted by pharmacist and attendant. The indoor hospital Swasti has 30 beds with separate arrangements for isolation cases. X-Ray and Pathological tests are done. Total 176 indoor cases and 7065 outdoor cases were treated during the year 2022-23.

On 21st May 2023 a free Medical Checkup and Treatment Camp was organized in our Campus with the help of Lions Club of Dibrugarh. 09 (nine) specialist doctors (Orthopedician, Dermatologist, Ophthalmologist, Dentist, Medicine, General Physician & Pathologist) who are generally unavailable for poor villagers residing in remote jungle areas attended the camp. A total no of 222 patients were treated and supplied with free medicines. A Pediatric Cancer awareness special class was conducted by Dr. Mriganka and Dr. Alok Barua, Dibrugarh.

On 17th December 2023 a free Medical Checkup and Treatment Camp was organized by Dr. U K Paul, Dermatologist and Dr Rupam Paul, Child Specialist, Tinsukia, Assam in our Campus. Atotal no of 107 patients were benefitted and supplied with free medicines.

Dairy and Poultry:

The Dairy and Poultry unit supplies fresh milk, eggs and chicken to the kitchen for the benefit of resident students. During the year as report 27,803.1 ltrs. Milk, 1,93,369 nos. Eggs and 6,391.20 kg Meat were produced.

Agriculture:

Under Land Utilization Unit varieties of vegetables are produced in our vegetable garden throughout the year. The total production during the year is 3,500 Kgs. There is a regular supply of fresh vegetables to our kitchen and staff members. Besides, 15,035 kg of tea leaf and 2,272 kg of dry coffee seeds were produced during the year.

In the fishery, seven ponds are maintained to give a regular supply of fish to the kitchen. Total production during the year is 360 kg.


Youth Convention
