Classes - I to IX Students will be permitted to go home on Saturday, the 14th March, 2026 after 12.00 noon.

The guardians are requested to note the following :

1. Students should reach the hostel on Saturday, the 25th April, 2026 between 8.30 a.m. and 3.30 p.m. The timings for reporting at the hostel should be strictly adhered to.
2. If the ward is sick or suffering from any disease they should not be sent to the school until they are completely fit. Absence due to illness should be duly intimated to the Principal in advance, and medical certificate is to be produced upon return.
3. Please mention the name of the ward and the class in which he is studying in all the correspondences.
4. Students are not permitted to bring Mobile Phones, Wrist Watches, Transistors, Tape-Recorders, Cameras, Cycle or any costly articles to the Hostel. Also they should not bring "DAAO" or any other "WEAPONS" along with them. Only students of Class IX, X, XI & XII may bring wrist watch.
5. Guardians are not to give money directly to their wards. Money should be deposited in the beginning of the Session with the Central Office into the ward's personal A/C for his Sundry expenses.

Items mentioned below should be procured from Boy's Store (approx. expenditure - Rs. 6000/6500) :

6. **Bed & Bedding** : Pillow with cover & towel, mosquito net, bed-sheet etc.

Uniform : Dormitory Uniform (1 set), P.T. Shoes (one pair), School Shoes (one pair), Blue Socks (two pairs), Black Socks (two pairs), Umbrella (one), Hawaii Chappal (one pair), School belt, badge, Note Books (one set). PT Uniform (2 sets), Dormitory Uniform (1 set) will be provided from Boys Store free of charges.

Students must arrange on their own : School Uniform (2 sets) and Prayer Hall uniform (2 sets).

7. A separate circular will be issued in due course regarding the payment of Session Charges etc.
8. If a ward, studying in class **3 to 9 does not secure pass marks**, they have to be **withdrawn from the Hostel**.
9. If a ward studying in **Class 5 and 8 does not secure above pass marks in School Consolidated and above 60% APSB Exam** respectively, they have to be **withdrawn from the hostel**.
10. Every student must observe strict discipline both in the School and in the Hostel. Violation of the rules and regulations of the Institution may lead to take disciplinary action to the extent of termination.
11. Hostel students are not expected to keep with them home clothings and to go out of the campus without the permission of the hostel authority.
12. Parents/Guardians are allowed to meet their wards only on the **first Sunday of every month**, between **8.30 a.m. to 12 noon and 2.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m.**
13. If the parents cannot come personally to take their ward, person authorized by them may take their ward during the vacation.
14. The ward may be contacted over the phone during the following hours as per the schedule mentioned below.
 - A) May to September – Between 3.30 p.m. – 5.30 p.m. (for classes I to IX)
Between 4.30 p.m. – 5.30 p.m. (for classes X, XI, XII)
 - B) November to March – Between 3.30 p.m. – 5.00 p.m. (for all classes)
