Students will be permitted to go home on **Wednesday, the 16th September, 2026 after 12.00 noon.**

The guardians are requested to note the following :

- Students should reach the hostel on Friday, 30th October, 2026 between 8.30 a.m. and 3.30 p.m. The timings for reporting to the hostel should be strictly adhered to.
- Students are not permitted to bring Mobile Phones, Wrist watches, Transistors, Tape-Recorders, Cameras, Cycle or any costly articles to the Hostel. Also they should not bring "DAAO" or any other "WEAPONS" along with them. Only students of class - IX, X, XI & XII may bring wrist watch.
- Students should have the following items with them for the next term : Full Sweater-1 No, Half Sweater-1 No, Woolen Socks - 2 Pairs, Muffler-1 No, Woolen Cap - 2 Nos. These will be available at our boys' store.
- Guardians are not to give money directly to their wards. Money should be deposited with the central office into the ward's personal account for his sundry expenses.
- If any ward is sick or suffering from any disease they should not be sent to school until they are completely fit. Absence due to illness should be duly intimated to the principal in advance, and medical certificate is to be produced upon return.
- Please note that the ward's continuance here next year will depend not only on good results but also on good behaviour and conduct in all respects.
- If a ward, studying in **Class 3 to 9 and 11 does not secure pass marks**, they have to be **withdrawn from the hostel**.
- If a ward studying in **Class 5 and 8 does not secure above pass marks in School Consolidated and above 60% APSB Exam** respectively, they have to be **withdrawn from the hostel**.
- Students of classes X and XII due to appear in the board examination in 2026 may not be allowed to take the said examination, if their academic performance in the ensuing **Pre-Test and Test Examinations is not found satisfactory and up to the mark**.
- Kindly mention the name of the ward and the class in which he is reading, in all correspondence with the school authority.
- Parents/guardians are allowed to meet their wards only on the first Sunday of every month between 8:30 a.m. to 12 noon and 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- The ward may be contacted over the phone during the following hours on the days mentioned below. Please ring earlier to inform the office to ensure their availability.
 - May to September – Between 3.30 p.m. – 5.30 p.m. (for classes I to IX)
Between 4.30 p.m. – 5.30 p.m. (for classes X, XI & XII)
 - November to March – Between 3.30p.m. – 5.00 p.m. (for all classes)

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ACHIEVEMENTS AND EVENTS

1. In **class X (AISSE-2026)**, 46 students appeared and 46 passed; 42 passed in 1st Division and 03 in 2nd Division. 06 students scored 90% and above, 22 scored 80% and above, 31 scored 75% and above. Master Doni Bagra was the highest scorer with **94.80%**.
2. In **class XII (AISSE-2026)**, 31 students appeared and 31 passed; 31 passed in 1st Division. 01 students scored 90% and above, 08 students scored 80% and above, 15 students scored 75% and above. Master Nyali Ete was the highest scorer with **93.00%**.
3. **25th May to 4th June 2026 Educational and Cultural Exposure Visit to IIT Kharagpur and Kolkata.** A group of 10 students of Ramakrishna Mission, Narottam Nagar, including 6 students from Class IX and 4 students from Class VIII, accompanied by two escort teachers, left Narottam Nagar on 23rd May 2026 to participate in the 11th International Convention organized by SPIC MACAY at Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur from 25th to 31st May 2026. After the convention, the troupe visited several important spiritual, historical, and educational places in Kolkata on 1st and 2nd June 2026. The students paid their respects at Belur Math and Dakshineswar Kali Temple and also visited Ramakrishna Math, Dakshineswar. Educational visits were made to Victoria Memorial and Science City, Kolkata.
4. **2nd - 7th May 2026 Visit of Most Revered President Maharaj, Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission, Belur Math and Consecration and Inauguration of Abhedananda Bhavan (Boys' Hostel) and other events.**

Revered President Maharaj arrived at Ramakrishna Mission Narottam Nagar on 2nd May 2026 from Belur Math.
On 3rd May 2026, Revered Maharaj consecrated Swami Abhedananda Bhavan, the newly constructed four-storey boys' hostel of the institution. The foundation stone of the building had been laid on 21st May 2022 by Shri Amit Shah, in the presence of Revered Maharaj, who was then serving as a Vice President of the Order.
On 4th May 2026, Abhedananda Bhavan was formally inaugurated by Shri Chowna Mein, Honourable Deputy Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh. The programme was attended by Shri Pasang Dorjee Sona, Honourable Education Minister; Shri Wangki Lowang, Honourable Minister for Environment, Forest and DoTCL; Shri Wanglin Lowangdong, MLA Borduria; along with ZPM, DC, SP, DDSE Tirap, and other officers.
Earlier on the same day, Revered President Maharaj laid the foundation stone for 'Sarada Mandap' at the confluence of the Dihing and Chatjo rivers near the Ashrama campus.
