Students will be permitted to go home on Saturday, the 21st September, 2024 after 12.00 noon.

The guardians are requested to note the following:

- 1. Students should reach the hostel on Friday, 05th November, 2024 between 8.30 a.m. and 3.30 p.m. The the timings for reporting to the hostel should be strictly adhered to.
- 2. Students are not permitted to bring Mobile Phones, Wrist watches, Transistors, Tape-Recorders, Cameras, Cycle or any costly articles to the Hostel. Also they should not bring "DAAO" or any other "WEAPONS" along with them. Only students of class IX, X, XI & XII may bring wrist watch.
- 3. Students should have the following items with them for the next term: Full Sweater-1 No, Half Sweater-1 No, Woolen Socks 2 Pairs, Muffler-1 No, Woolen Cap -2 Nos. These will be available with our boys' store.
- 4. Guardians are not to give <u>money directly to their wards</u>. Money should be deposited with the central office into the ward's personal account for his sundry expenses.
- 5. If any ward is sick or suffering from any disease they should not be sent to school until they are completely fit. Absence due to illness should be duly intimated to the principal in advance, and medical certificate is to be produced upon return.
- 6. Please note that the ward's **continuance here next year** will depend not only on **good results** but also on **good behaviour and conduct in all respects.**
- 7. If a ward, studying in Class 3 to 9 and 11 does not secure pass marks, they have to be withdrawn from the hostel.
- 8. If a ward studying in Class 5 and 8 does not secure above pass marks in School Consolidated and above 60% APSB Exam respectively, they have to be withdrawn from the hostel.
- 9. Students of classes X and XII due to appear in the board examination in 2025 <u>may not be allowed</u> to take the said examination, if their academic performance in the ensuing **Pre-Test and Test Examinations** is not found satisfactory and up to the mark.
- 10. Kindly mention the name of the ward and the class in which he is reading, in all correspondence with the school authority.
- 11. Parents/guardians are allowed to meet their wards only on the <u>first sunday of every month</u> between 8:30 a.m. to 12 noon and 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- 12. The ward may be contacted over the phone during the following hours on the days mentioned below. Please ring earlier to inform the office to ensure their availability.
 - A) May to September Between 3.30 p.m. 5.30 p.m. (for classes I to IX) Between 4.30 p.m. 5.30 p.m. (for classes X, XI,XII)
 - B) November to March Between 3.30p.m. 5.00 p.m. (for all classes)
